

Introducing a new scholarship application system of Chiba University

Chiba University started a new scholarship application system to support excellent graduate students from overseas. The scholarship selection of this system includes the following 4 scholarships; “MEXT scholarship (university recommendation)”, “Chiba University Excellent International Student Scholarship”, “Chiba University Partnership Program” and “JASSO Honor scholarship”. With this application system, we will be able to notify about 25 students who wish to enter Chiba University that they have been accepted for a scholarship before they arrive in Japan.

【Outline】

- Those who wish to apply for the scholarships below must follow the directions of their prospective supervisor in Chiba University, and complete e-mail registration by the designated date. Applicants are requested to send a recommendation letter and a transcript by post mail.
- Chiba University will grade the candidates in December according to academic records etc., and will select be selected grades 1 to 5.

【The merits of system】

- Grade 3 is a combined “Partnership Program (Only exemption of tuition fee and entrance fee)” and “Honors Scholarship (¥48,000/month)”.
- Overseas graduate students will be able to increase their chances of winning a scholarship before coming to Japan, due to this unified grading system.
